## Irvington production company shoots robbery training video

Mattingly Productions of Irvington was recently on location in the Washington, D.C., area shooting scenes to update a training video for the Navy Federal Credit Union.

The video, "In Case of Robbery," provides guidelines on how credit union employees can help prevent a robbery, what to do during a robbery and what to do following one.

The 20-minute production uses dramatic vignettes to illustrate and support the guidelines. Liz Marks Casting of Richmond provided the actors.

Suzanne and Grayson Mattingly in the mid-'90s, "In Case of Robbery" was used throughout Navy Federal, the world's largest credit union. After viewing it, the FBI asked to use it to train other credit unions and banks across the country. The National Credit Union Association also helped distribute the program.

The 2008 version includes information about new technologies now in use by credit union and other financial institutions. Mattingly Productions provided full scripting, production, editing and duplication services.
